Bible verses to read together

For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

Romans 1:20

The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of God's hands.

Psalm 19:1

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Genesis 1:1

God has made everything beautiful in its time. Also, God has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end.

Ecclesiastes 3:11

And the earth brought forth grass, the herb that yields seed according to its kind, and the tree that yields fruit, whose seed is according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

Reflection on creation care and its importance:

3 Questions to get started: WHAT, WHY and HOW.

- 1. What is creation care?
- 2. Why do we need to care for creation?
- 3. How should we care for the creation?

WHAT is creation care?

God created this world. As we read from Genesis 1, God created the heaven and the earth, then went on to create the day/night, land/sea, plants, animals, birds and humans. God placed everything in this world, then looked at everything God made and was pleased with it (Gen 1:31).

Creation Care is nothing but following God's call to be good stewards of everything that God made so wonderfully and thoughtfully.

WHY should we care for creation?

Gen 2:15 says, "Then the Lord God placed humans in the Garden of Eden to cultivate it and guard it."

The Bible tells us that humans are called to guard creation. It's an important responsibility that our God entrusted on us. Every living being on this earth has a purpose. We rely on each other. Imagine a world without trees or birds or water. We won't be able to survive! It is our responsibility to safeguard what God has made. It is one of the most fundamental things we're called to do. If we claim to care for God, we should care for this wonderful creation.

HOW do we safeguard it?

Every little action matters. Each one of us can help safeguard or care for our creation in little ways. We can start by implementing small changes in our daily lives. Small actions such as replacing the plastic bags with reusable ecofriendly bag when we're going for grocery shopping. We can ditch personal vehicles for public transport more often to minimize CO2 emissions. Planting



trees and cleaning up our surroundings are also little ways that we can remember our call to care for all of creation.

We know that many human actions have caused damage to this world. We see so many changes in our local communities every day: Once lush forest dropped down to concrete structures, sudden storms, rising cases of floods, scorching heats or severe winters. There's ecological imbalance. Climate change is real. As Christians and humans, let's do our little bit to care for God's creation because we have been called to do so. We can make a big difference, there's power in our hands.

All we need to do is to act together. One step at a time.

Discussion questions

As your small group or church has read the bible verse and reflections above consider:

Where do you see God's creation? Is creation more than just the environment?

Where do you see the effects of pollution in your local environment?

Is it important for us to look after the environment?

How have you been called by God to "cultivate"?

How do you care for your creation? What else could you do?

How do you involve all generations in creation care? How do we empower youth and young people to be leaders and participants?

How can your church or small group be involved in creation care?
